MINUTES ARISING FROM PREVIOUS MEETING

Toilets Stall Design: Inspired by seeing this on FB and noting that there are some students who retreat to the toilets thought it would be good to decorate the toilets to give them something. Colour Palette is soft pastels. Covers both the physical and emotional side of things. Each stall has their own design inside. The Dark Background with girls blowing leaves is on the very front. Year 12 General Art class did it with some boys helping out as well. Spare study periods people will help to get it finished. Kai Preshaw did the design for the girl. Plans for the boys toilets are there – not enough time right now but in future the boys might get done (perhaps next year). For the project the Year 12's spoke as a group, decided on the thoughts and theme around it and then went off individually to think of the quotes. Should be completed soon.

FoF Charter Updates: Kelly to send Mel the soft copy so Melody can update the signatories entry. Debit card account only requires one signatory, which is what will be updated. Limited funds in the account at any time to try and avoid fraud. \$1000 limit per day – agreed at meeting.

Aqualife Passes: The lady Sabrina spoke to is on leave. Vouchers for 3-day consecutive pass to their Leisure Centres. Term 4 we can think of how to disperse them to parents somehow.

Balmoral Auxiliary Role: Email exchange between Sam and Sarah (Conway). She has a lot on between work and house building etc. So will hopefully look at taking up the role next year. Trying to get 20-30 kids there from Frayne, bearing in mind there are some students who are also at parishes who may be involved. Go onto the website for more info. There are highlights there of the days. 8-10 December. 15-16 year olds through to 30's. Biggest message that comes out is a sense of belonging. Can the College get sponsorship for ten students? \$2.5k in sponsorship total. Sarah Quin has put this out as an Expression of Interest. Insert info around how to select those students.
