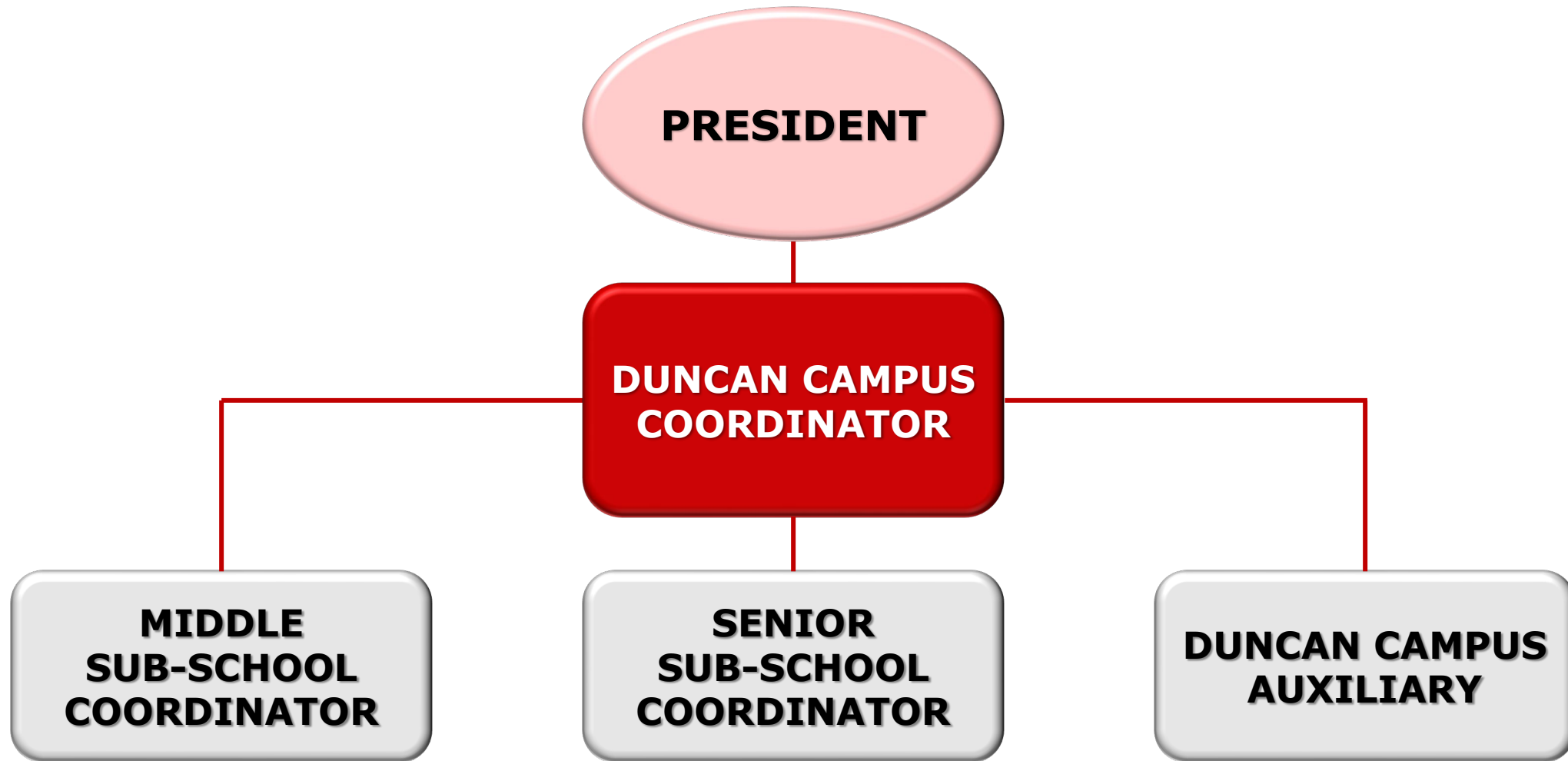
# FRAYNE GRADUATE STATEMENT

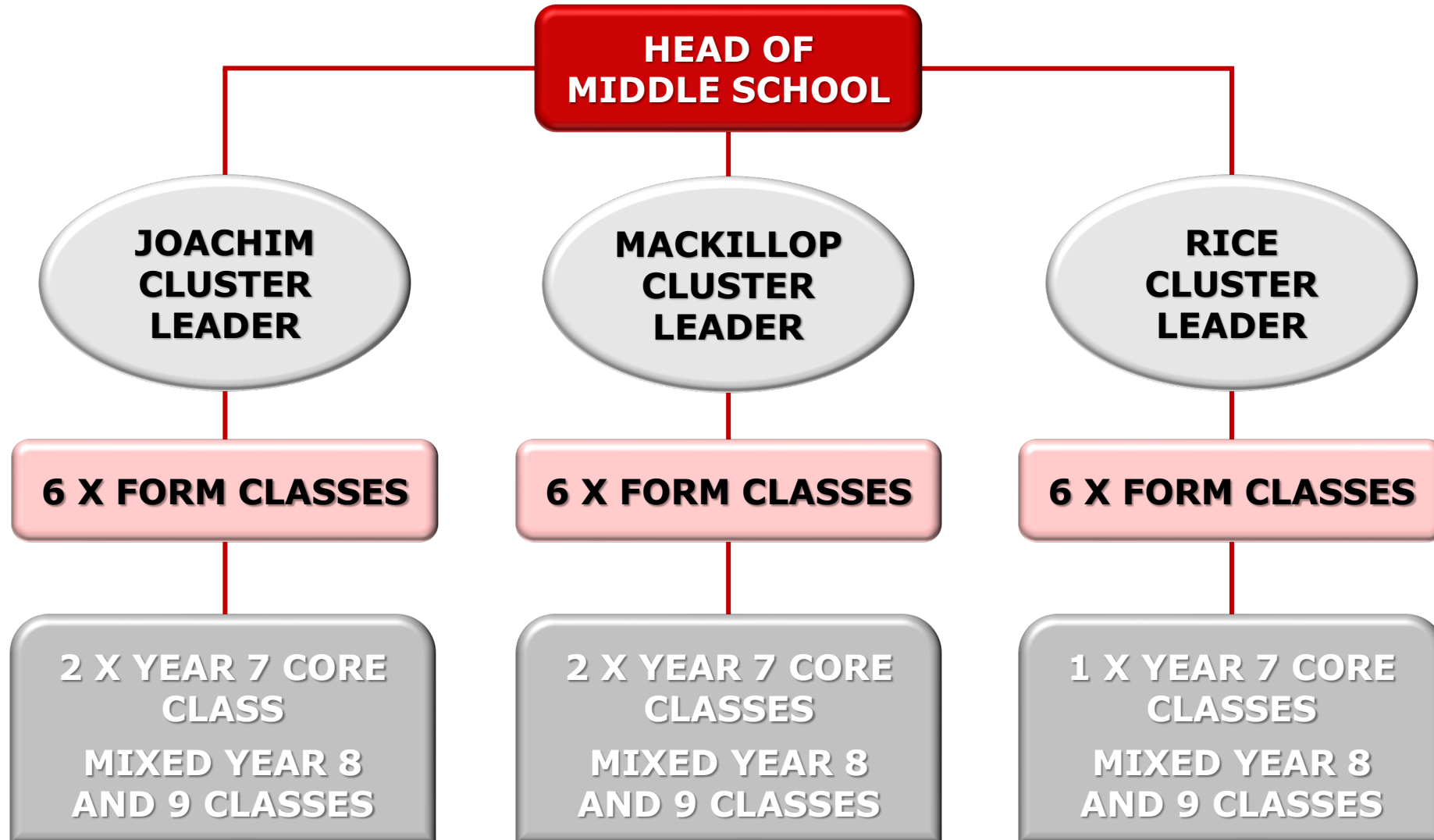
