



iPad care

Suggestions for best care of your iPad:

Students are responsible for the general care of their iPad.

General Precautions

1. Only use a clean, soft, lint free or microfibre cloth to clean the screen. Abrasive cloths, towels, paper towels, and similar items may cause damage to the item.
2. No cleansers of any type are to be used on the iPad.
3. Keep liquid away from the iPad and do not let any moisture get into any openings.
4. iPads should not be exposed to extreme temperature (i.e. left in a car, sun exposure).
5. Cords and cables must be inserted and removed carefully into the iPad to prevent damage.
6. iPads must never be left in an unlocked car or any unsupervised area.

Screen Care

The iPad screens can be damaged if subjected to rough treatment. The screens are particularly sensitive to damage from excessive pressure on the screen.

1. Do not lean on the top of the iPad when the case is closed.
2. Do not place anything near the iPad that could put pressure on the screen in your bag.
3. Do not place anything in the carrying case/backpack that will press against the cover.
4. Clean the screen with a soft, dry cloth, microfibre or anti-static cloth.
5. Do not "bump" the iPad against desks, walls, etc. as it will eventually break the screen.
6. Only a stylus designed for an iPad should be used.

Carrying iPads

Your iPad must have a sturdy, robust cover which also protects the corners securely.

1. When using the iPad for audio or camera recording ensure you are holding the iPad securely.
2. iPads should always be within the protective case
3. Some carrying cases can hold other objects (such as folders and workbooks), but these must be kept to a minimum to avoid placing too much pressure and weight on the iPad screen.
