1. It is compulsory for all students to study **Religion & Life** and **English** in Year 11. Mathematics is highly regarded. Students can select these courses at a level which best suits their individual needs. At least one List B subject must be studied.
2. ATAR courses chosen in Year 11 will continue into ATAR courses in Year 12.
3. Students who wish to gain direct access to University from secondary school are advised to select a minimum of four ATAR courses in Year 11.
4. Students who take Mathematics Specialist ATAR may either study 7 subjects or take 5 study periods per week. Mathematics Specialist is run off the grid.
5. General courses do not generally lead to University Entrance subjects in Year 12. Students who wish to pursue a TAFE/Workforce pathway are encouraged to select these subjects.
6. Students who wish to take Workplace Learning must submit a written application and attend an interview before they are accepted.
7. English Foundations is for students who have not yet demonstrated the literacy standard in the Online Literacy and Numeracy Assessment (OLNA).
