YEAR 12, 2021 WACE RESULTS

The College is very proud of the achievements of the Class of 2021 in the recent Western Australian Certificate of Education (WACE) examinations and overall Year 12 achievement. Congratulations to the students and staff who have worked hard to maintain such high standards given the extra challenges of the last few years.

RESULTS OVERVIEW

98.65% of our Year 12 students achieved the Western Australian Certificate of Education (WACE).

Of the students eligible to obtain an ATAR:

2021

15 students. (16.5%) of ATAR students above 95

28 students. (30.3%) of ATAR students above 90

50 students. (54.9%) of ATAR students above 85

64 students. (70.3%) of ATAR students above 80

Our median Australian Tertiary Admission Rank (ATAR) of 87.05 was above the State median of 81.75. Based on the median ATAR score for all students who enrolled in four or more ATAR courses, Ursula Frayne ranked 21 in the state. The College has been ranked in the Top 50 secondary schools in Western Australia for the last ten years. In 2021 the College was measured against 194 schools.

We were recognised as a high-performing school (Top 15%) in English, Maths Applications, Literature, Modern History, Religion & Life and AIT. English ATAR achieved the highest average for any Catholic college in 2021.

71 students out of 98 out of have been offered their first preference at University this year (this includes students from various pathways).

Through our **ASPIRE** Vocational Education and Training program, numerous students successfully transitioned into TAFE or university. Every student who undertook a Certificate IV program was offered a university placement.

For students from Year 12 who undertook a VET subject over Years 11 & 12:

29 students achieved a Certificate IV

56 students achieved a Certificate III

110 students achieved a Certificate II

The ASPIRE program helped 14 students receive traineeships and apprenticeships.

Subject Certificate of Excellence

A Subject Certificate of Excellence is awarded to eligible candidates who are in the top 0.5 per cent of candidates in each ATAR course examination set by the Authority

Awards for Consistent Achievement at School

A Certificate of Distinction or Certificate of Merit is awarded to each eligible student who, in their last three consecutive years of senior secondary WACE enrolment, achieves: Certificate of Distinction 190-200 points and Certificate of Merit

150-189 points. When a student received 20 A grades over Year 11 & 12, they are awarded a Certificate of Distinction. Students who attended our Balmoral Campus for primary school are noted by the asterisk.
