# ENROLMENT PRIORITY

The Principal welcomes applications from families who wish to share in the mission of the Ursula Frayne Catholic College community.

While an offer of a position is at the discretion of the Principal, the Principal takes into consideration the following criteria:

- Priority is given to applicants whose parents have demonstrated a concern for the religious development of their child.
- Priority is given to applicants who, in the estimation of the Principal, are likely to benefit most from enrolment at the College.

No correspondence will be entered concerning the reasons for decisions regarding offers of places.

## BALMORAL CAMPUS (PREPARATORY AND JUNIOR SCHOOLS)

After consideration has been given to the criteria above, priority is accorded to applicants in the following order:

- Catholic students from the associated parishes with a Parish Priest reference.
- Catholic students from other parishes with a Parish Priest reference.
- Other Catholic students from the associated parishes.
- Other Catholic students.
- Siblings of non-Catholic students.
- Non-Catholic students from other Christian denominations.
- Other non-Catholic students.

## DUNCAN CAMPUS (MIDDLE AND SENIOR SCHOOLS)

After consideration has been given to the criteria above, priority is accorded to applicants in the following order:

- Catholic students from Catholic primary schools with a Parish Priest reference.
- Catholic students from non-Catholic primary schools with a Parish Priest reference.
- Other Catholic students from Catholic primary schools.
- Other Catholic students from non-Catholic primary schools.
- Siblings of non-Catholic students.
- Non-Catholic students from Catholic primary schools.
- Non-Catholic students from other Christian denominations.
- Other non-Catholic students.

## **ENROLMENT PROCEDURES**

Parents complete and return the Application Form to the Enrolments Officer with photocopies of the student's Birth Certificate, Baptism Certificate, Immunisation statement issued by the Australian Immunisation Register and most recent School Report, together with the non-refundable Application Fee of AUD\$40.00. Before places are offered, parents and students will be invited to attend an interview.

Parents are required to submit a separate Enrolment Application Form for each child. No students have automatic right of entry, even though they may attend a Catholic primary school or have siblings attending the College.

For enrolments in Kindergarten, interviews will usually be conducted early in the year preceding the student's entry to the College. For enrolments in Year 7, the focal year cohort for interviewing, offering places and finalising acceptances is usually Year 5.
