

Friends of Frayne - Council Role Description Junior Sub-School Coordinator

Term of appointment: Minimum of one (1) year.

PRIMARY OBJECTIVE:

The Junior Sub-School Coordinator supports the Balmoral Campus Coordinator in bringing together the Class Coordinators and parent help from the Junior School and to assist at Friends of Frayne run events and College events where the Friends of Frayne provide support.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Comply with the Catholic School Parents Western Australia Group (CSPWA) Terms of Reference and the college Code of Conduct.
- Act and be seen to act in the best interests of the Friends of Frayne and its operations, and the school.
- Promote a spirit of community and co-operation amongst parents.
- Support the Balmoral Campus Coordinator with their key tasks throughout the school year.
- Report to the Balmoral Campus Coordinator.

KEY TASKS:

- Liaise with and provide support/guidance to the Junior School Class Coordinators.
- In consultation with the Balmoral Campus Coordinator, liaise with the Head of Junior School on matters requiring Friends of Frayne support (minimum of 1 meeting per semester, or if preferred 1 meeting per term).
- Assist the Balmoral Campus Coordinator with executing Friends of Frayne events and initiatives.
- Assist the Friends of Frayne with the promotion of events within the Junior School.
- Attend and encourage parents to attend Friends of Frayne meetings and get involved.
- Abide by the Terms of Reference.
