## Junior School Learning Technology Device requirements for 2024

The use of technology to enhance the learning process is embedded in the Western Australian Curriculum and Ursula Frayne Catholic College is committed to ensuring that students' learning, competencies and capabilities are enhanced and extended through the integration of technology across all curriculum areas. It is compulsory for every student from Years 3-6 to bring a sufficiently charged device to school each day in 2024. We need to ensure consistent access and optimisation of the College's learning environment. This initiative aims to ensure all our students are well prepared to become confident and capable future citizens who have the skills and expertise to allow them to move into a future workplace that will increasingly rely on the latest technological knowledge and digital literacies.

Due to the uncertainty around Apple's ability to produce devices currently, we will be hosting a parent information session on Thursday 2 November from 6-7pm. If you can attend, please complete the following <u>registration form here.</u>

**Required Device:** The minimum specification for the 2024 academic year for **Year 3 students** or students **new to Junior School** is the **2023 iPad 9<sup>th</sup> Gen with 256Gb storage**. Please note the 2023 ipad 10<sup>th</sup> Gen with 256Gb storage is also available although this has a higher price associated with it. Devices should be selected to last the four years of Junior School and be able to keep up with the demands of the curriculum for those four years.
