RE: YEAR 11 ATAR BIOLOGY: TWO-NIGHT CAMP IN DRYANDRA WOODLAND NATIONAL PARK

An assessable requirement (15%) of the Year 11 Biology ATAR course is for students to apply their understanding of ecological processes and conservation management in a field-based context. As such, a two-night excursion to the Dryandra Woodland National Park has been organised. Students will partake in the data collection and sampling of local species, as well as engaging with active conservation strategies and interacting with threatened native fauna. Your child will complete field-based booklets which contributes to their overall grade.

All National Park activities will be run by officers of the Department of Biodiversity, Conservation and Attractions, and Ursula Frayne Catholic College staff. Dormitory-style accommodation has been organised for the students and staff (Mr Gian Custodio, Ms Kim Duffecy, Mrs Jodie Boulton and Mrs Megan Goodhew) for both nights at the Lions Dryandra Woodland Village. Meals will be prepared by staff with the assistance of students. Specific dietary requirements will be catered for, and food safety and hygiene protocols will be applied.
