This term, students in Integrated Studies have been focusing on the 1920s and World War II as the History component of their Humanities programme. Next term, our focus will shift to the history of Justice in Australia, with a particular focus on the rights of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people. In order to explore these topics, students are invited to attend an excursion visiting two historical locations in Fremantle: The Army Museum of Western Australia and Fremantle Prison. At each location, students will be directed by tour guides to expand their understanding and connection to topics discussed in class.
