Dear Parents/Caregivers

Re: Year 11 and Year 12 Exam Break

The Year 11 and 12 Examinations will be conducted between Monday, 20 May and Friday, 31 May. Please click [here](#) to access the 2024 Semester 1 Year 11 and Year 12 Examination Timetable.

Year 12 students return on Tuesday, 4 June for periods 1-4. Several practical exams will take place from periods 5-7. For Year 12 students not involved in practical exams the school day will conclude after period 4.

Year 11 students will not be required to attend school on Tuesday, 4 June except those students involved in practical exams from periods 5-7. This day should be spent preparing for the Year 11 Leadership Retreat by completing activities set by Ms Chloe McGinnity, Head of Year 11, and Ms Sarah Quin, Director of Mission and Identity. The Year 11 Leadership Retreat runs from Wednesday, 5 June until Friday, 7 June. Regular classes recommence on Monday, 10 June.

Students are only required to attend school when they are sitting an examination or completing outstanding work for this fortnight. Any student who attends school during this time must wear their correct winter uniform. Year 12 students may wear their Leavers' Jackets during the examination period.

EXAMINATION RULES AND EXAMINATION PREPARATION

Students and their parents are asked to read all documents carefully to ensure they are clear about the examination process.

For Year 12 students, 2023 WACE Examination papers are available on the School Curriculum and Standards Authority website <https://senior-secondary.scsa.wa.edu.au/>. Students who wish to meet teachers during the examination period for support are to contact the subject teacher ahead of time. These students will need to sign in at Student Services and be in full winter uniform.

STUDENTS NOT SITTING WACE EXAMINATIONS

Any student who is not up to date with their schoolwork and/or has not completed required tasks by the beginning of the examination period, will be required to attend school during this time to complete any outstanding work. This communication will be forwarded by their respective teacher via SEQTA Engage. These students will need to sign in at Student Services and be in full winter uniform.

When not attending school, it is recommended that students utilise this time to catch up on their Workplace Learning requirements, Christian Service Learning hours, or use this time to investigate post-secondary school options.
