Uniform Policy

## RATIONALE

## Students wear a uniform -

1. to develop a sense of student unity and School Pride;
2. to minimise differences resulting from socio-economic background; and
3. to de-emphasise differences in appearance and to focus on the real purpose of schooling - the development of anindividuality of intellect, imagination and personality.

## PRINCIPLES

It is the responsibility of all parents and students to ensure that the correct school uniform is worn to school each day. A daily check of uniform standards during Homeroom/Class will be conducted. It is the responsibility of students to ensure that the school uniform is worn correctly during school hours and whilst traveling home from school.


Boys

College trousers with black leather belt, unless trousers have an elastic backing, College shirt, appropriate tie*, red jumper (optional), College blazer, charcoal College socks, black leather lace-up shoes, College scarf (optional).

* Students in Years 10, 11, 12 wear the Senior School tie.

NOTE: Belts must be made from black leather. 'Skate' belts and belts made from 'webbed' and/or 'woven' material are not appropriate.

College blouse tucked in, College skirt, appropriate tie*, red jumper (optional), College blazer, black tights, black lace-up shoes, College scarf (optional).

* Students in Years 10, 11, 12 wear the Senior School tie.

NOTE: The length of skirts should reach the lower part of the knee.

Trousers optional, blouse tucked in and charcoal College socks.

College trousers, College shirt, tie, jumper, charcoal College socks, black leather lace-up shoes, College scarf (optional)

College skirt, College blouse, tie, red jumper, white College socks or black tights, black leather lace-up shoes, College scarf (optional).

NOTE: The length of the skirts should reach the lower part of the knee.

Trousers optional, blouse tucked in and charcoal College socks.

## ATTIRE FOR FORMAL OCCASIONS

Formal Uniform $\quad$ The blazer is a compulsory part of the attire and winter uniform for students on the Duncan Campus and is worn to and from school.

Girls are required to wear black tights if wearing the College skirt for formal occasions.

Terms 1 \& 4: Summer uniform (boys wear ties).

Terms 2 \& 3: Winter uniform including jumper.

Girls are required to wear black tights if wearing the College skirt for formal occasions.

## SPORT/PHYSICAL EDUCATION UNIFORM

Sport/Physical Education Uniform

All students (Years 1-12) are required to purchase the correct College sport uniforms. The correct College sport uniform is to be worn for all PE lessons, ACC Sport, relevant Outdoor Education classes, Dance classes, training sessions and extracurricular sport sessions.

All other classes, including PE electives, Dance, Drama and trainings etc will require students to getchanged before and after their classes.

|  | During Terms 2 \& 3, the College tracksuit must be worn to and from the College on the respective PE Day. (Duncan Street Campus Students only). <br> Appropriate sport shoes are to be worn. These are to be lace up, well supported sport shoes with non-marking soles. These can be of any colour. Students are not permitted to wear high top, basketball, skate, canvas, Vans, Volleys, Converse style shoes. <br> Plain White socks <br> Appropriate racing bathing attire for aquatic events or College bathers. |
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| HOUSE COMPETITION UNIFORM - Duncan Street Campus |  |
| House Competition Uniform (Year 7-12 Only) | The College has coloured polo shirts for each House. <br> Students will be required to wear the House polo shirt for all Cluster activities. However, for all inter-school and general Physical Education classes, students will wear the normal College red sports shirt. <br> The purchase of the House shirt is compulsory for all students on the Duncan Street Campus. |
| OTHER ITEMS AND ACCESSORIES |  |
| College Bag | College bag (compulsory) |
| College Sports Bag | College sports bag (optional) |
| College Hat or Cap | College hat or cap (compulsory) <br> Duncan Street Campus <br> The College hat or cap should be kept in the student's locker and must be worn at special outdoor events and to all outdoor Physical Education classes, unless the activity involved deems otherwise. Students are strongly encouraged to wear their College hat/cap during recess and lunch breaks. <br> Balmoral Street Campus <br> The College hat or cap should be kept in the student's bag and must be worn at all times for all outdoor activities. The College has a "No hat, no play" policy. |
| Jewellery | - One wrist watch <br> - One flat surfaced ring without raised stones or gems. <br> - One plain gold or silver sleeper/stud in each earlobe. Shapes or small objects are not permitted. <br> - Additional "clear plastic studs" are not permitted <br> - One neck chain with appropriate religious object (to be worn inside shirt) <br> - One thin metallic bracelet. Bracelets with charms are not permitted. |


| Shoes | Ursula Frayne Catholic College aims to follow Occupational Health and Safety guidelines in relation to safety and footwear. Occupational Health and Safety requirements prohibit students participating in practical activities in school if not wearing substantial footwear deemed safe by the College. Unsafe shoes include those with openings; platform or high heels; shoes made from un- protective, open-weave materials such as canvas and cottons or similar; and other materials that do not provide adequate protection. <br> School shoes are described as traditional plain all black hard leather lace-up fully enclosed shoes with a stout sole. Shoes must not have raised or platform heels or soles and heel heights must be between 1 cm and 3 cms . <br> Fashion shoes such as skateboard, slipper type or moccasins are not permitted. |
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| Hair | General principles for all students include: <br> - Hair should be clean and kept neat and tidy. <br> - Hair styles should be business-like and conservative. <br> - Hair should be the natural colour. No brightly coloured or streaked hair or multi-coloured hair, natural tints only. <br> - Neat collar length or longer hair is to be tied back off the face (no top knots). <br> - Ribbons, scrunchies or flat headbands must be in the colours of red, white or black only. Additional hair accessories such as butterfly clips, other decorative hair clips or hair extensions are not permitted. <br> - Braids or dreadlock hairstyles are not permitted. <br> - No shaved heads (ie no shaving below a "number two" cut). Hair length should be blended rather than having extreme differences in lengths (such as undercuts, low/high fades and mohawks). <br> - Excessive gel, mousse or wax is not permitted <br> - Sideburns must not be any lower than half way down the ear and the face must be clean shaven at all times. <br> - Rat's tails are not permitted. <br> The acceptability of any hairstyle is at the discretion of the Principal or their delegate (Head of School) and students will be expected to adjust their hairstyle without question. |
| Makeup | - No makeup to be worn, including painted nails. <br> - No tattoos. <br> - No artificial nails are permitted. <br> - No false eyelashes. |
| Undergarments | - Should be white or flesh coloured. <br> - Collars/necks of T-shirts should not be visible. <br> - T-shirts must be plain. |
