



# URSULA FRAYNE CATHOLIC COLLEGE

## COLLEGE STUDENT UNIFORM

### RATIONALE

Students wear the College uniform to:

- develop a sense of unity and pride in our College.
- focus on the core purpose of Frayne as a learning and faith sharing community

### PRINCIPLES

It is the responsibility of all parents and students to ensure that the correct College uniform is worn each day. It is the responsibility of students to ensure that the uniform is worn correctly during school hours and whilst travelling to and from school.

### SUMMER UNIFORM

The summer uniform is compulsory for ALL students and is to be worn in Terms 1 and 4.

#### XAVIER CAMPUS (K-YR 6)

##### Kindergarten:

- College green polo shirt with logo
- Black shorts/skirt of choice (College shorts are optional)
- Closed in sports shoes; however, sandals with a back strap are an option in Summer

**Pre-Primary:** College Sport Uniform (red polo shirt and black shorts)

##### Option 1: Years 1- 6

- College shirt
- College shorts
- Charcoal grey College socks
- Black leather lace-up shoes

##### Option 2: Years 1 – 6

- College dress
- White College socks
- Black leather lace-up shoes

##### PLEASE NOTE:

- *Shirts can be untucked with shorts.*
- *The length of the dresses should reach the lower part of the knee.*
- *Red College jumper is optional.*
- *No visible undergarments.*

#### JOACHIM CAMPUS (YR 7-12)

##### Option 1:

- College shirt
- College shorts/trousers
- Plain black belt, unless trousers have an elastic backing.
- Charcoal grey College socks
- Black leather lace-up shoes

##### Option 2:

- College dress
- White College socks
- Black leather lace-up shoes

##### PLEASE NOTE:

- *Belts must be made from black leather.*
- *The length of dresses should reach the lower part of the knee.*
- *Shirts can be untucked with shorts.*
- *Shirts must be tucked in with trousers.*
- *Red College jumper is optional.*
- *No visible undergarments.*

## WINTER UNIFORM

The winter uniform is compulsory for ALL students and is to be worn in Terms 2 and 3.

### XAVIER CAMPUS (K-YR 6)

#### Kindergarten:

- College green polo shirt with logo
- Black tracksuit/skirt of choice (College black tracksuit is optional)
- Jumper of choice
- Closed in sports shoes

**Pre-Primary:** College Sport Uniform (red polo shirt black tracksuit and Sport jacket is optional)

#### Option 1: Years 1 – 6

- College trousers/shorts
- College shirt
- College tie
- Black belt (unless trousers have an elastic backing)
- Charcoal grey College socks
- Black leather lace-up shoes

#### Option 2: Years 1 – 6

- College shirt
- College skirt
- College tie
- White College socks or black tights
- Black leather lace-up shoes.

#### PLEASE NOTE:

- *Shirt must be tucked when worn with trousers/shorts and skirts.*
- *The length of the skirts should reach the lower part of the knee*
- *Red College jumper and scarf are both optional.*
- *Black tights are to be worn if wearing the winter skirt for formal occasions.*
- *Belts must be made from black leather.*

### JOACHIM CAMPUS (YR 7-12)

#### Option 1:

- College trousers
- College shirt
- College tie
- College blazer
- Black belt (unless trousers have an elastic backing)
- Charcoal grey College socks
- Black leather lace-up shoes

#### Option 2:

- College shirt
- College skirt
- College tie
- College blazer
- White College socks or black tights
- Black leather lace-up shoes

#### PLEASE NOTE:

- *Students in Years 10, 11 & 12 wear the Senior School tie.*
- *Shirts must be tucked when worn with trouser and skirts.*
- *The length of skirts should reach the lower part of the knee.*
- *Belts must be made from black leather.*
- *Red College jumper and scarf are both optional.*
- *Black tights are to be worn if wearing the winter skirt for formal occasions.*

## ATTIRE FOR FORMAL OCCASIONS

### XAVIER CAMPUS (K-YR 6)

#### Years 1- 6

Terms 1 & 4: Summer Uniform

Terms 2 & 3: Winter Uniform

- Black tights are to be worn if wearing the winter skirt for formal occasions.

### JOACHIM CAMPUS (YR 7-12)

Terms 1 & 4: Summer Uniform

Terms 2 & 3: Winter Uniform with blazer.

- Black tights are to be worn if wearing the winter skirt for formal occasions.

# SPORTS UNIFORM

## XAVIER CAMPUS (K-YR 6)

### Kindergarten:

Refer to Summer and Winter Uniform requirements.

### Pre-Primary:

Refer to Summer and Winter Uniform requirements.

### Years 1- 6

- College sport polo shirt
- College sport shorts
- College tracksuit (Xavier Campus style)
- Plain white socks
- Sport Shoes
- Hat

## JOACHIM CAMPUS (YR 7-12)

- College sport polo shirt
- College sport shorts
- College tracksuit top (Duncan Street Campus Style)
- College tracksuit pant (Duncan Street Campus Style) optional
- Plain white socks
- Sport Shoes
- Hat

### PLEASE NOTE:

- *The College sport uniform is to be worn for all PE lessons, ACCSp*
- *ort, relevant Outdoor Education classes, Dance classes, training sessions and co-curricular sport sessions.*
- **All other classes**, including Dance, Drama and trainings etc will require students to get changed before and after their classes.
- *During Terms 2 & 3, the College tracksuit pant is optional, but no other type of tracksuit pant may be worn instead.*
- *College jumper may not be worn with the sports uniform.*
- *Appropriate sport shoes are to be worn. These are to be lace up, well supported sport shoes with non-marking soles. These can be of any colour. Students are not permitted to wear high top, basketball, skate, canvas, vans, Volleys, converse style shoes.*
- *One-piece black swimsuit for girls and black bathers for boys are required for aquatic events.*

## OTHER ITEMS AND ACCESSORIES

### BOTH CAMPUSES

College Bag	College bag (compulsory) <b>Pre-Primary - Yr 12 only</b>
College Sports Bag	College sports bag (optional)
College Hat or Cap	College hat or cap (compulsory)  <b>Xavier Campus</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The College hat should be kept in the student's bag and must be always worn for all outdoor activities. The College has a "No hat, no play" policy.</li> </ul> <b>Joachim Campus</b> The College cap should be kept in the student's locker and must be worn at outdoor events and to all outdoor Physical Education classes, unless the activity involved deems otherwise. Students are strongly encouraged to wear their College cap during recess and lunch breaks.
Shoes	Occupational Health and Safety requirements prohibit students participating in practical activities in school if not wearing substantial footwear deemed safe by the College. School shoes are described as traditional plain all black hard leather lace-up fully enclosed shoes with a stout sole. Shoes must not have raised or platform heels. Soles and heel heights must be between 1-3cm.
Jewellery	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>One wristwatch</li> <li>One flat surfaced ring without raised stones or gems.</li> <li>One plain gold or silver sleeper/stud in each earlobe. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Shapes or small objects are not permitted.</li> <li>Large hoops are not permitted</li> <li>No hanging charms are permitted</li> <li>Small clear stone (diamante) is permitted</li> <li>Additional "clear plastic stud" in the upper ear (helix) is permitted. Both front and back of earring must be clear</li> <li>Students are not permitted to wear clear earrings in their lobes or other body parts</li> </ul> </li> <li>One neck chain with appropriate religious symbol (to be worn inside shirt)</li> <li>One thin metallic bracelet. Bracelets with charms are not permitted.</li> </ul>
Hair	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Hair should be clean, neat and tidy.</li> <li>Hair styles should be conservative.</li> <li>Hair should be the natural colour.</li> <li>Neat collar length or longer hair is to be tied back off the face (no top knots).</li> <li>Ribbons, scrunchies or flat headbands must be in the colours of red, white or black only. Additional hair accessories such as butterfly clips or other decorative hair clips are not permitted.</li> <li>Hair length should be blended rather than having extreme differences in lengths (such as shaved head, undercuts, low/high fades and mohawk).</li> <li>Excessive gel, mousse or wax is not permitted.</li> <li>Sideburns must not be any lower than halfway down the ear and the face must be always clean shaven.</li> </ul>

	The acceptability of any hairstyle is at the discretion of the Principal or their delegate (Head of Year) and students will be expected to adjust their hairstyle without question.
Cosmetics	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• No makeup to be worn, including painted nails.</li><li>• No tattoos</li><li>• No artificial nails are permitted</li><li>• No false eyelashes</li></ul>
